The University of Alberta will annually present an award honouring the best coverage by an Alberta community newspaper of the university's students, research activities or coverage of provincial post-secondary education issues in general.

The recipient of the award will have written a story or series of stories that accomplishes one or more of the following criteria: a) recognizes the positive contribution of University of Alberta research for/within a community b) profiles University of Alberta student(s) who are making significant contributions through their post-secondary education c) provides awareness and insight into issues and/or developments surrounding post-secondary education in Alberta

1. Editor should submit the best article(s) highlighting University of Alberta students, research in the newspaper's community or issues surrounding post-secondary education.
2. Entries must be selected from an issue published between April 1, 2009 and March 31, 2010.
3. Judging will be arranged by the University of Alberta and the judges' decision will be final.

ENTRY DEADLINE : May 13, 2010

1. Go to www.betternewspapercontest.com
2. Click on "Newspaper Login" (upper left)
3. Select 2010 AWNA Premier Awards from the Contest drop down menu
4. Select your newspaper from the News Organization drop down menu
5. a) If this is your first time here, enter the temporary password 'bnc'.
b) If you have logged in previously, enter the password you chose for yourself.
6. If this is your first time here, you are asked to choose a password, for account security. When you are logged in and viewing your 'dashboard' and can see from here the entries and info you have submitted so far.
 1. To add an entry:
 - a. hover mouse over "My Contest" (upper left), and select "Submit Entry"
 - b. Choose a category and fill in the appropriate fields
 - c. Click Browse to upload your entry (or the hi-res PDF page that you submitted to AWSOM is ideal)
 - d. Click Submit
